

Helictite

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In 1974 the Speleological Research Council agreed to support the Journal with financial assistance and in 1976 took over full responsibility for its production. From 1974 to 1997 the Journal was edited by Julia James assisted by other members of the Speleological Research Council Ltd. In 1998 Susan White and Ken Grimes took over as editors with Glenn Baddeley as Business Manager. Stefan Eberhard joined the editorial team in 2003.

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This will be the last printed issue of *Helictite*.

Future papers will be published online, and freely available to all. There will be no subscription fee – the ongoing costs of production will be borne by the ASF. Printed copies will be available, 'on demand', for a fee based on the costs.

The papers will still be reviewed and edited as before, but the layout will change to suit an electronic format. We will discontinue the 'volume/number' approach and publish each paper as it is ready with a sequential number that incorporates the year of issue. There may be some teething problems, especially in finding the most appropriate layout style. Intending authors should read the latest Author's Guide available on the *Helictite* website.


